



General Rules

In each sport Championships:

- Teams cannot share players within the same competition. No player can play with two teams in the same competition. The sanction will be the loss of both matches in which he/she played.
- Teams are urged to be present at least 20 minutes before their scheduled matches at the assigned sport facilities, and report to the person in charge of the corresponding competition.
- Please note that assigned times are match start times and will not be accept any delay of arrival time of the team/player, after the starting time of the match. If not in the field on time, the team/player will be automatically penalized with the loss of that match.
- Matches will be conducting in running time, due to the tightness of the Schedules.
- Any disrespectful attitude towards the referee(s), table official(s) or opponents will be automatically penalized with the loss of the match.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to disqualify any player, coach, official or follower from these events if found to be in infraction of the rules and regulations set for these Championships.
- It is absolutely forbidden to perform any political claims and references during the events.
- Any harassment or act of discrimination based on sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, physical characteristics, disability, ethnicity, country of origin or political ideas will not be tolerated within the World InterUniversities Championships

Participation:

Only the following may participate as athletes in the World InterUniversities Championships:

- a) Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the University or similar institute
- b) Former students of the institutions mentioned in a) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year of the event

Insurance

IUSF Federation and WIUC organization do not provide medical insurance. Each participant must be insured personally or through their university/sports team. Ambulance/doctor/medical staff will be present in the sports centers during the course of the matches.

Staff

All teams must treat Championships staff with respect (referees, table officials and organization staff). All Championships staff members also understand that they have the same obligations towards all participants. All sanctions resulting from any infraction(s) will be decided by the "World InterUniversities Championships" Organizing Committee.

ACCREDITATION SYSTEM

Only people with the Official badge of the WIUC 2024 will be allowed to get inside the sport centers. Carry your badge always with you!

ACCESS TO THE SPORT CENTERS

For reasons of security and overall capacity, entry to some sports centers will be limited to a certain number of people. Once the maximum capacity is reached, access to the sports center will not be possible: volleyball (ToLive Sport Center), Basketball (PalaFonte, Elite Basket/PalaColle La Salle, Città Futura) and Table Tennis (ITIS Armellini). Once you have finished your match, please leave the field/sports center for those who are to compete.

For outdoor sports centers, admission MAY be restricted for safety reasons if a large number of people (this does not include athletes who must compete) are reached.

Awards Ceremony

. CHAMPIONSHIPS LEVEL (more that 8 teams)

1ST PLACE:

TROPHY + MEDALS FOR ALL PLAYERS + CONTRIBUTION of 500 euro to be used for the registration to the 10th World InterUniversities Championships (for all sports except tennis, tennis table, badminton, padel)

TROPHY + MEDALS FOR ALL PLAYERS + CONTRIBUTION of 300 euro to be used for the registration to the 10th World InterUniversities Championships (for tennis, tennis table, badminton, padel)

. TOURNAMENTS LEVEL (less than 8 teams)

1ST PLACE:

TROPHY + MEDALS FOR ALL PLAYERS

FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS AND TOURNAMENTS Level

2ND - 3RD PLACE: CUP + MEDALS for all players

4TH PLACE: CUP

Best player (football, futsal, basketball, volleyball, rugby): TROPHY

Tennis, Tennis Table, Badminton, Padel, Swimming and Athletics: Individual Male, Individual Female and Mixed/Doubles Tournaments and all the races for Swimming and Athletics will have the Awards Ceremony directly on the field with medals at the end of each event and later, the best 4 Universities (in the summation of all the tournaments/races), will be rewarded with cup also during the Awards Ceremony, at the end of all the Championships.

BEST UNIVERSITIES RANKING

4.000 euro for the Best Universities (to be used for the registration to the 10th World InterUniversities Championships):

Best University in the Championships: 1.500 euro

2nd University: 1.000 euro

3rd University: 700 euro

4th University: 500 euro

5th University: 300 euro

Criteria:

For Best Universities Ranking:

For each Championship sport, the winning team(s) will be awarded (gain):

- 1ST place - 10 POINTS;
- 2ND - 7 POINTS;
- 3RD - 5 POINTS;
- 4TH - 3 POINTS
- 5th place - 6th place - 7th place - 8th place: 1 POINT

Score for Swimming and Athletics Individual/Relay Races:

The first, second and third placed in each competition, will be awarded with medals, directly on site at the end of the race.

Overall Swimming and Athletics World InterUniversities Champion (Team):

Only the best athlete and the best relay for any university will be awarded points for the final result(s).

Points awarded in order of ranking and only to the best player for the best athlete/relay per University:

1st: 10 points; 2nd: 8 p.; 3rd: 6 p.; 4th: 5 p.; 5th: 4 p.; 6th: 3 p.; 7th: 2 p.; 8th: 1p.

The Best 4 Universities in the summation points of all the swimming competitions and all the athletics races, will be awarded also during the Awards Ceremony, on Saturday at the end of all the Championships.

Score for Tennis, Tennis Table, Badminton single male, single female, double mix and Padel (double male and double female):

Individual Male, Individual Female and Double Tournaments

The first, second and third placed in each tournament, will be awarded with medals, directly on site at the end of the competition.

Overall World InterUniversities Champion (Team):

The Best 4 Universities in the summation of the all tournaments, will be awarded also during the Awards Ceremony, at the end of all the Championships.

. Criteria:

In each individual tournament, only the best athlete of each University will receive points for the final result. (points will be awarded only in knock-out matches ; no points can be awarded to athletes who did not pass the group stage)

Also in the mixed and double tournaments, only the best team from each University will receive points for the final result. (points will be awarded only in knock-out matches ; no points can be awarded to team who did not pass the group stage).

Points will be awarded starting with the first runner-up and scaled up to the best runner-up and so on (respecting the criteria of 1 per University).

To award points after the top 4 finishers (finals), the games won in the last match played (for tennis and padel) and the points scored in the last match played (for badminton and table tennis) will be considered.

In case of a further tie: the one who lost in the head-to-head match against the best ranked player is considered as the best.

Points: 1st 10 points; 2nd 7 p.; 3rd 5 p.; 4th 3 p.; 5th 1 p.; 6th 1 p.; 7th 1 p.; 8th 1 p.

LIVING IN CHAMPIONSHIPS VILLAGE/HOSTEL/HOTEL and in THE SPORT CENTERS

REMEMBER THESE FEW SIMPLE RULES

1. drinking any kind of alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, vodka, whisky)
2. smoking cigarettes (in the sport centers)
3. breaking glasses

- Respect – you are expected to behave appropriately. Please do not make noise when coming into the hostel/hotel from the parties or damage things in the Hostel/Hotel.
- Food & Beverages – take care while handling food and drinks at the sports centre.
- Fair play – in order for everyone to enjoy the games, to guarantee equal chances and to secure your participation in the “World InterUniversities Championships”, please be aware that Fair play is requested from everyone. Please keep in mind: it's a game, we don't want you to seriously hurt each other.
- Friendship – at “World InterUniversities Championships” we would like to create an atmosphere of friendship, camaraderie and understanding among participating universities. This implies treating each other respectfully.
- Tolerance – We just want everything to be perfect, but the organization of “World InterUniversities Championships” could suffer setbacks and unexpected events and/or delays in matches if you fail to respect the timetables, therefore: be patient and flexible in your standing!

Please understand that we reserve the right to exclude participants who are strongly violating these general rules of behaviour in order to ensure an environment in which everybody may feel relaxed and comfortable.

The Championships organization is the exclusive competence and right of IUSC Committee and WIUSF Federation SSD A RL. The enrolment at these Championships implies the complete adherence and acceptance of these Regulations. WIUSF Federation SSD A RL declines any and all responsibilities for incidental accidents. The Referees are entrusted to the organizing staff and to the players' fair play.
