Padel Championships Official Rules

TOURNAMENTS:

- Men's Double
- Ladies' Double

MATCHES: 1 set of 6 games; in case of 5-5, there will be a tie-break at 7, at 6-6 next point win the tie-break.

SCORING: Matches to be played with no-ad (no advantage) scoring: at 40-40 (deuce) next point wins the game. All games, including tie-break, are won by a margin of only 1 point. When the match ends, the winner must bring padel balls to the staff members and report the final score.

POOLS RANKING: 1 point for each match won; 0 point for each match lost. If there is tie, the difference between games won and games lost will be counted.

SURFACE: Indoor/outdoor synthetic turf.

TIME: We strongly recommend to be at the sports center at least 1 hour before the scheduled start of the match, there may be time changes.

NOTE: In case of bad weather the organizing committee reserves the right to modify the format of the competition matches.

Awards and Points

Double Male and Double Female

The first, second and third placed in each tournament, will be rewarded with medals, directly on site at the end of the competition.

Overall Padel World InterUniversities Champion (Team):

The Best 4 Universities in the summation of the 3 tournaments, will be rewarded also during the Awards Ceremony, at the end of all the Championships.

Criteria:

In each tournament, only the best double of each University will receive points for the final result. In case of a tie in the total score, the university that is highest ranked in the tournament with the highest number of participating teams will be the winner.

Awards:

 1^{st} Place: Trophy + a CHEQUE of 300 euros to be used for the registration in the " 10^{th} World InterUniversities Championships".

2nd, 3rd and 4th places: Cup

Also: The organizing committee reserves the right to make changes, of any nature, including change in times, if they are in the best interest of the Championships. Teams will obviously be notified of the changes in time. All players must take note of the rules of the game including the aforementioned exceptions.
