Swimming Championships Official Rules

The Swimming Competition will be conducted in accordance with the WORLD AQUATICS regulations (www.fina.org)

Team size

- . There is no limit on the number of competitors and relay team that each university can register in the races
- . Only the best competitor and the best relay for any university will be awarded points for the final result(s).

Competition

Swimming Championship's venue is Zero9 (via Cina 91); the pool is based of 25mt with 10 lanes.

The following events shall be included in the Championship. All events shall be conducted for both male and female competitors.

- 50m freestyle, butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke - M/F
- 4x50 m medley relay - M/F
- 4x50 m freestyle relay - M/F
- 200m medley - M/F
- 200m freestyle - M/F
- 4x50 m freestyle relay mix

Heats and finals will be held for each events. For individual competitions, a maximum of two athletes per team will enter the final stages; just one relay per team will enter the final stages.

Swimming Suits

The swimming suits used by all swimmers at the "World InterUniversities Championships" must comply in full with WORLD AQUATICS rule and duly approved by WORLD AQUATICS in accordance with the rules and procedures set forth in the WORLD AQUATICS Requirements for Swimwear Approval. In any case, the referee of the competition will decide whether to exclude any swimmer whose swimming suit does not comply with the WORLD AQUATICS rules.

- Swimsuit is compulsory and must be in good moral taste.
- Swimming cap is compulsory
- Goggles are optional

Awards and Points

Score for Swimming Individual/Relay Races:

The first, second and third placed in each competition, will be awarded with medals, directly on site at the end of the final sections.

Overall Swimming World InterUniversities Champion (Team):

Score for Individuals and Relays:

Only the best swimmer and the best relay for any university will be awarded points for the final result(s).

1st: 10 points; 2nd: 8 points; 3rd: 6 points; 4th: 5 points; 5th: 4 points; 6th: 3 points; 7th: 2 points; 8th: 1point.

- The University scoring the most points in each event, shall be the winner for that event. If two (2) or more teams score equal number of points to tie for first place they shall be joint winners

The Best 4 Universities in the summation points of all the swimming competitions will be awarded also during the Awards Ceremony, on Saturday at the end of all the Championships.

Awards:

1st Place: Trophy + a CHEQUE of 300 euros to be used for the registration in the "10thWorld InterUniversities Championships"

2nd, 3rd and 4th places: cup

Also: The organizing committee reserves the right to change the format of the Championships if it is in the best interest of competitors and based on organizational needs. The team will obviously be warned of the changes in time.

Every coach and player must take note of the rules of the competition with the exceptions above. With this document we would like to acknowledge that you know and are aware of the rules of the competition and accept them for this Championship.
